## **Literacy Update**

Year 5s will focus on analysing a range of non-fiction text by using strategies such as identifying the main idea, asking questions and looking at big thinking. Students will continue to work on their CAFÉ reading goals to improve their reading and conference with their teacher one on one. During writing, we'll be looking at the text type description and discussion, ending the year with publishing their writer's gift.

Year 6 will continue to deepen their understanding when reading, viewing or listening to texts. They will keep a non-fiction focus, in preparation for high school. We'll keep reading through our own personal reading journey, with CAFE skill goals as individuals or in groups. During Writing, we have been finalising our work on poetry and will shortly be moving on to narratives. Toward the end of the term our students will be finalising pieces and publishing for our Writer's Gift.

## **Numeracy Update**

Year 5 will be looking at geometry translation, rotation, reflection and enlarging objects. They will also review their multiplication and division skills, followed by equivalent number sentences. Problem solving will continue to be a focus throughout the term, using the 6s strategy when tackling problems.

Year 6 students will work on reviewing their multiplication and division skills. Following this will review decimals and statistics. Students will also experience a range of problem solving tasks that cover strategies such as working backwards, drawing diagrams and using simpler numbers. As per previous terms students will continue their work in EMM.

## **Graduation Update**


